5. Korzeniowski Warsaw Race Walking Cup

§ 1

[Organizer]

1. The organizer of the "**5. Korzeniowski Warsaw Race Walking Cup**," hereinafter referred to as the **Meeting or KWRWC**, is the Robert Korzeniowski Foundation, with its registered office in Warsaw (02-797), at 121d Nowoursynowska Street, entered into the Register of Associations, other social and professional organizations, foundations, and independent public healthcare facilities of the National Court Register, maintained by the District Court for the capital city of Warsaw in Warsaw, 13th Commercial Division of the National Court Register, under KRS number 0000810061, Tax Identification Number (NIP) 5213880252, National Business Registry Number (REGON) 384688770, hereinafter referred to as the **Organizer**.

§ 2

[Goals]

1. Promoting walking as the simplest form of exercise.
2. Promoting physical activity and a healthy lifestyle.
3. Promoting Warsaw as a city friendly to people who actively participate in sports.

§ 3

[Date and Location]

1. The meeting will take place on April 25, 2026, in Warsaw.
2. The location, start time, detailed route, and information regarding the Race Office's operations will be available at www.walkingkorzeniowski.com
3. The organizer reserves the right to suspend or interrupt the competition in the event of a storm, other extreme weather conditions, natural disasters, or other factors that prevent the safe continuation of the competition.
4. If it is not possible to safely organize and conduct the Meeting, the Organizer reserves the right to change the date of the event.

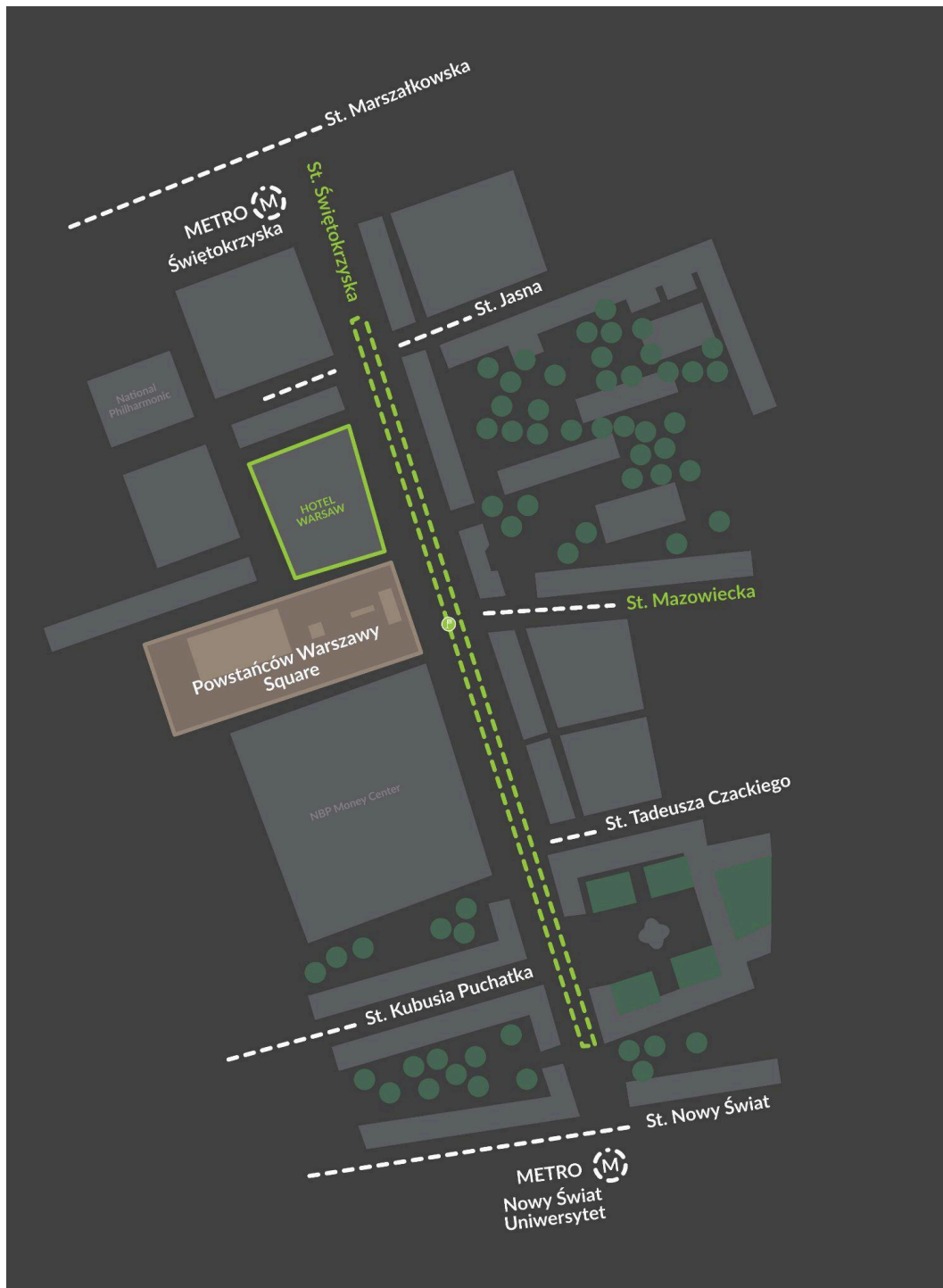


§ 4

[Competition Route]

1. The route will be World Athletics certified.
2. The route runs in a straight line (along Świętokrzyska Street), with two 180-degree turns (before Marszałkowska and Nowy Świat Streets).
3. The length of one loop is 1000 m, the surface is entirely asphalt.
4. The start and finish lines will be located at Swietokrzyska street, next to the Powstańców Warszawy Square.
5. The route will be marked every kilometer and 500m.
6. The route will feature:
 - a. 1 refreshment point with water
 - b. 1 refreshment point with athletes' own drinks - only for athletes taking part in 10K and 21,0975 km
 - c. toilet cabins near the start, refreshment point and at the finish line
 - d. medical point at the finish line
7. The organizer does not accept private supplements from competitors, except for competitors competing in the ELITE OPEN category.
8. The organizer reserves the right to change the route as well as the starting time, and will inform the competitors about this by posting the new route on the website www.walkingkorzeniowski.com
9. The change of the competition route as well as the start time does not constitute a basis for making any claims against the Organizer, nor does it constitute a basis for creating additional obligations for the Organizer, which the competitors acknowledge and accept.

§ 5

[Distances and age categories]

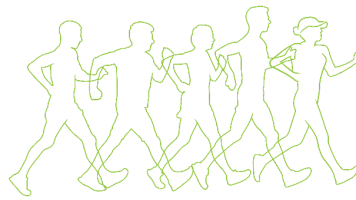
1. The meeting is open to all race walkers:
 - a. those with a valid PZLA license – for participants of OPEN Elite and Polish Championships
 - b. Masters categories associated with the Polish Athletics Association
 - c. representing individual national athletics federations
2. The following categories and distances apply during the Meeting:
 - a. ELITE Open (women and men), including participants of the Polish Walking Championships – distance: 21,0975 km
 - b. U23 and U20 (women and men) – distance 10 km
 - c. U18 (women and men) – 5 km distance
 - d. U16 (men) – 5 km distance
 - e. Masters (men) – 5 km distance
 - f. U16 (women) – distance 3 km
 - g. Masters (women) – distance 3 km
 - h. U14 (girls and boys) – distance 2 km
 - i. U12 (girls and boys) – distance 1 km
 - j. U10 (girls and boys) – distance 1 km



§ 6

[Time limit]

1. The time limit for completing the route for each category is:
 - a. ELITE Open (women and men), including participants of the Polish Walking Championships – 2 hours
 - b. U23 and U20 (women and men)– 60 minutes
 - c. U18 (women and men) – 40 minutes
 - d. U16 (men) – 40 minutes
 - e. Masters (men) – 40 minutes
 - f. U16 (women)– 30 minutes
 - g. Masters (women) – 30 minutes
 - h. U14 (girls and boys) – 20 minutes
 - i. U12 (girls and boys) – 15 minutes
 - j. U10 (girls and boys) – 15 minutes
2. Participants who do not reach the finish line within a specified time from crossing the starting line are strictly obliged to discontinue the competition and leave the route.
3. Time measurement will be performed electronically using chips attached to the starting number and, in parallel, using a photo finish.
4. The order of Participants at the finish line will be determined based on the achieved net times (except for the first 50 competitors, who will be classified based on the official gross times - from the starter's shot).



§ 7

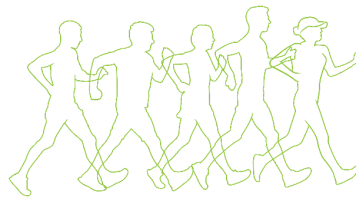
[Conditions of participation]

1. Only persons who:
 - a. they will submit an application using the KWRWC registration form referred to in § 8 of these Regulations and,
 - b. have no health contraindications to participate in the competition - an integral part of the application is a DECLARATION about the lack of health contraindications to participate in the Meeting, which each competitor should mark at the time of registration and,
 - c. will collect their starting number with a timing chip before the start, during the designated opening hours of the Race Office.
2. The Organizer allows the participation of persons who are at least 16 years old on the day of the start and who have provided the Organizer with the written consent of their legal representative or legal guardian and a medical certificate stating that there are no contraindications to participation in the Meeting.
3. For safety reasons, the KWRWC does not allow participants using bicycles, roller skates, inline skates, skateboards, or other mechanical devices. Walking with animals is also prohibited. An exception is the participation of an assistance dog, particularly a guide dog for a blind or visually impaired person or an assistance dog for a mobility impaired person. The animal must be on a leash, the collar cannot be spiked, and participants are required to maintain a safe distance from other participants.
4. Due to the nature of the competition, starting with poles (trekking and Nordic Walking) is prohibited.



5. By appearing at the starting line, the competitor acknowledges that they are participating solely at their own risk, and in the case of minors, at the risk of their parents or legal guardians. The competitor, parent, or legal guardian, in the case of minors, assumes the associated risks, acknowledging that participation in the Meeting involves significant physical exertion and carries inherent risks and hazards of accidents, the possibility of bodily injury and trauma (including death), as well as property damage and loss, and voluntarily accepting this risk. The foregoing does not exclude the organizer's liability under mandatory provisions of law.
6. For safety reasons it is prohibited to:
 - a. bringing items onto the Meeting route that may pose a threat to other competitors;
 - b. participating in the Meeting in clothing that covers the face and prevents the identification of the competitor
7. The Organizer may prohibit participation with an item not described in § 7 section 6, which will affect the safety of competitors, volunteers and the Organizer.
8. The Starter Packs will be collected at the place and time indicated by the Organizer.
9. Each competitor must be verified at the Competition Office. Verification can be made:
 - a. in person – based on an ID document with a photo
 - b. by an authorized person – based on inspection of a photocopy/photo of the participant's identity document and written authorization.

- c. The authorization will be available on the website www.walkingkorzeniowski.com 30 days before the Meeting.
 - d. by a minor – based on written consent from a parent or legal guardian. The consent form will be published on the website www.walkingkorzeniowski.com no later than 30 days before the Meeting.
10. The Organizer provides personal accident insurance to competitors who have been properly verified at the race office. Each participant will be covered by accident insurance for accidents occurring during the insurer's liability period within the territory of the Republic of Poland, resulting in bodily injury or health impairment, resulting in permanent health impairment or death of the insured person. The premium is paid by the Organizer.
 11. Individual insurance in the event of an injury or other unfortunate event that may happen to the Participant during the Meeting requires a separate policy (in particular life insurance, health insurance, civil liability insurance in the event of illness, accident, death or damage that may occur in connection with the Participant's presence or participation in the Meeting), purchased individually by the Participant.
 12. During the Meet, all Participants must wear their starting numbers pinned to the front of their shirts. Covering the starting number, in whole or in part, or modifying it (cutting, folding, etc.) is prohibited.
 13. It is prohibited to be on the meeting route without a valid bib number. Those without a valid bib number will be asked to leave the route by the meeting route staff.
 14. Meeting participants are obliged to strictly follow the instructions of the Organizers, the services responsible for traffic management, including the Police, Municipal Guard, judges and other services securing the Meeting route.
 15. Meeting participants are prohibited from shortening the route under pain of disqualification.
 16. Persons found to be under the influence or in possession of any narcotics, illegal substances and/or alcoholic beverages will not be allowed to participate in the Meeting.



17. In the event of an injury or fainting of a Participant, persons in the immediate vicinity of the competitor should notify the Organizer and, in justified cases, also the Medical Assistance.
18. The medical staff's decisions regarding the continuation of the meeting are final and unquestionable. Medical transport of an athlete will result in disqualification.
19. If a competitor decides to withdraw from the Meeting at any time during the competition, he or she is obliged to report this fact to the Organizer.

§ 8

[Registration]

1. Registration for the Meeting will take place via the registration form, hereinafter referred to as the Form, which can be accessed via the link on the website www.walkingkorzeniowski.com from February 1 to April 20, 2026 or until all places are filled.
2. The condition for participation in the Meeting is the correct completion of the Form containing personal and contact details.
3. Holders of PZLA licenses for individual race walking distances who register in accordance with § 8, paragraphs 1 and 2, will be simultaneously registered by the Organizer via the STARTER registration system at: www.starter.pzla.pl
4. The maximum number of participants is 500 people. If this number is reached, the Organizer reserves the right to close registration early.
5. The Organizer reserves the right to invite people to take part in the Competition after the limit of places has been reached.



6. The organizer reserves the right to change the limit of places, but everyone who has registered for KWRWC by the date of announcement of such a change has a guaranteed right to start.

§ 9

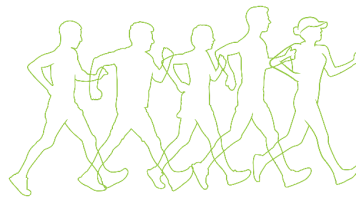
[Entry fee]

Participation in the Meeting is free of charge.

§ 10

[Benefits]

1. As part of participation in the Meeting, the Participant receives:
 - a. the opportunity to start in a selected age category;
 - b. basic medical service and medical support during the Meeting;
 - c. starting number and chip for electronic timing;



§ 10

[Benefits for ELITE players]

1. ELITE players include players who meet the following criteria:
 - a. The 6 best athletes of the 2024 Olympic Games
 - b. The 6 best athletes of the 2024 and 2025 World Championships (individually and in the Marathon relay)
 - c. champions of individual continents in 2024 and 2025
2. ELITE competitors are provided with three nights of accommodation with full board in a double room. The costs are covered by the Organizer.
3. If an ELITE player would like to share a room with an accompanying person (who does not meet the criteria specified in § 10 section 1), he/she is obliged to cover 1/2 of the costs for a double room.
4. If the Player wishes to share a room with a person who does not meet the criteria, he/she is obliged to provide appropriate information in the application form during registration, including the name and surname of the accompanying person.
5. ELITE competitors will be provided with transport between the airport or Warsaw Central Railway Station, provided they send the details of their travel to the Organizer by 20 April 2026.



§ 11

[Deposits]

1. The location and opening hours of the depository will be announced on the website www.walkingkorzeniowski.com
2. Items for deposit will only be accepted in deposit bags provided at the Race Office.
3. It is not possible to leave items in the depository that are not placed in the deposit bag.
4. The organizer is not responsible for valuables left in the deposit.
5. The bag can only be collected with the race number. If a participant loses their race number, the Organizer is released from responsibility for the bag being collected by another person.
6. The Organizer is not responsible for items left and unclaimed in the deposit area during the opening hours designated by the Organizer. Any items left behind or lost will be disposed of after the Meeting ends.

§ 12

[Classifications and awards]

1. The Meeting will feature a general classification divided by gender in each age category.
2. Additionally, the Polish Championship classification will be conducted for competitors with a valid PZLA license.



3. The first place winners in the general classification of women and men in each age category will receive statuettes.
4. The following financial prizes are provided for the best 6 competitors taking part in the 20 km OPEN Elite Meeting:
 - a. 1st place - 600 EUR
 - b. 2nd place - 500 EUR
 - c. 3rd place - 400 EUR
 - d. 4th place - 300 EUR
 - e. 5th place - 200 EUR
 - f. 6th place - 100 EUR
5. The prizes referred to in § 12 section 4 will be reduced by 10% local tax and will be transferred by bank transfer to the account indicated by the competitor or his official representative.
6. The organizer will not conduct separate classifications for disabled people.
7. Each Participant who completes the Meeting will receive a certificate of completion.
8. The pool of possible additional prizes will be covered by separate regulations, available 7 days before the Meeting date, subject to the possibility of obtaining sponsors.



§ 13

[Doping control]

1. During the Meeting, anti-doping tests will be carried out among participants.
2. Samples will be collected in accordance with the World Athletics Anti-Doping Regulations, by qualified anti-doping personnel.
3. Samples will be delivered to a WADA accredited laboratory.
4. An athlete competing in the ELITE Open category acknowledges that anti-doping and gender qualification testing will be conducted in accordance with World Athletics anti-doping rules and regulations and hereby consents to submit to any requirements relating to such testing during the Meeting.

§ 14

[Personal data protection]

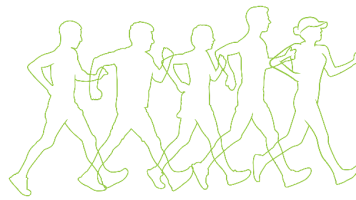
1. The controller of personal data of the Meeting participants, within the meaning of the Personal Data Protection Act of 10 May 2018 and the General Data Protection Regulation No. 2016/679 of 27 April 2016, is with its registered office in Warsaw (02-797), at 121d Nowoursynowska Street, entered into the Register of Associations, other social and professional organizations, foundations and independent public healthcare facilities of the National Court Register, maintained by the District Court for the capital city of Warsaw in Warsaw, 13th Commercial Division of the National Court Register under the KRS number 0000810061, Tax Identification Number (NIP) 5213880252, National Business Registry Number (REGON) 384688770 (hereinafter referred to as the "Controller").



2. The Administrator processes the personal data of Participants necessary for the proper performance of the contract, in accordance with the Act of 18 July 2002 on the provision of services by electronic means and on the basis of Article 6 paragraph 1 point a) and in accordance with the content of the General Data Protection Regulation No. 2016/679 of 27 April 2016, while maintaining the security principles required by the Act of 10 May 2018 on the protection of personal data.
3. The personal data processed by the Administrator are: first name, last name, date of birth, correspondence address, e-mail address, citizenship, mobile phone number, club membership and image.
4. The Administrator determines each time the data required to provide services electronically. The Administrator may process the following personal data, which may change depending on the type of services provided: surname and first names; residential or stay address; correspondence address; email address; landline or mobile phone number; gender; and date of birth.
5. By registering for the Meeting, the Participant accepts the Terms and Conditions and consents to the processing of their personal data by the Administrator. This consent includes, in particular, the processing of personal data for the following purposes:
 - a. name, surname, information about health condition, home address, e-mail address, telephone number for the purposes of participating in the Meeting;
 - b. name, surname, club affiliation for the purposes of publishing results or statistics;

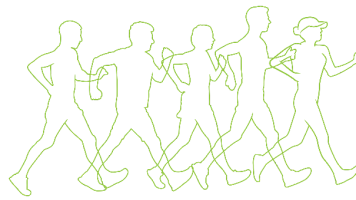


- c. name, surname and image for the purpose of publishing them on television, radio, on the Internet or in printed form for marketing and promotional purposes;
 - d. e-mail address for the purposes of sending information by the Organizer regarding events organized by the Organizer and for promotional and marketing purposes.
6. The Administrator transfers the personal data of participants in the form of: name, surname, telephone number, e-mail address - to entities processing personal data acting on behalf of the Organizer for the purpose of keeping records and performing time measurement, including the publication of statistics.
7. The Organizer may process personal data in connection with the organization of the event also in cooperation with other persons (e.g. volunteers distributing packages) who carry out activities related to the organization and conduct of the event.
8. The Administrator will not transfer personal data to countries outside the European Union that are the headquarters of the entities listed in point 4) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council. In the event of their transfer to third countries, the transfer will take place using appropriate safeguards referred to in Article 46 of the General Data Protection Regulation and the participant will be entitled to obtain a copy of them at the following place: Robert Korzeniowski Foundation, ul. Nowoursynowska 121d, 02-797 Warsaw. In particular, the personal data of competitors taking part in



sports competitions under the auspices of World Athletics will be transferred to World Athletics.

9. The Participant has the right to withdraw consent to the processing of personal data by the Administrator at any time.
10. Providing personal data by the Participant is voluntary, however, the lack of consent to their processing prevents participation in the Meeting.
11. The participant has the right to access the content of his/her data and to rectify it, delete it, limit its processing, the right to transfer data, the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing.
12. Participants' personal data may be made available to entities cooperating with the Organizer as part of the Meeting, in particular to Sponsors and Partners of KWRWC on the basis of appropriate entrustment agreements - this applies to the image of the Participant recorded by the Organizer in photos taken during the Meeting
13. The Participant has the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office if he or she considers that the processing of personal data concerning the User violates the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation No. 2016/679 of 27 April 2016.
14. All information regarding participants obtained by the Organizer and included in the registration form will be saved electronically and will in each case be used in accordance with applicable law.
15. The Organizer reserves the right to interview, photograph and film each participant for advertising and promotional purposes.



16. use on the Internet or in radio and television broadcasts and for other commercial purposes.
17. The organizer reserves the right to use all photos, video footage, interviews, and audio recordings of the competition participants free of charge worldwide. These may be used by the organizer on CD-ROMs, DVDs, portable devices such as flash drives, external drives, online clouds, in catalogs and media, on websites, in newspapers, at exhibitions, as well as for promotional and advertising purposes related to the organizer's activities.
18. The data storage period is:
 - a. for data processed for the purpose of pursuing possible legal claims – until the statute of limitations for the claim expires or until the proceedings related to pursuing the claims are completed;
 - b. for data processed for the purpose of documenting and informing about business activities – no longer than 5 years from the date of the documented event, unless the data are processed for archiving purposes in the public interest;
 - c. for data processed to ensure the security of networks and IT systems – no longer than 5 years from the date of registration;
 - d. for data processed on the basis of the Participant's consent – until such consent is withdrawn.

§ 15

[Final provisions]

1. Meeting participants are bound by the regulations of the Polish Athletics Association, World Athletics and these Regulations.
2. The Organizer draws Participants' attention to the numerous dangers and risks associated with participating in a sporting event involving intense physical exertion, which may include, among other things, the risk of loss of life and health. The Organizer recommends appropriate medical examinations or consultations before and during the Meeting, depending on the Participant's age and physical condition.
3. By accepting these Regulations, the Participant declares that he or she has no health/medical contraindications to participate in the Meeting.
4. Written protests regarding the results of the KWRWC may be submitted by email to the Organizer (fight) or by registered mail to the Organizer's correspondence address, with the note "Protest." Protests will be reviewed within 7 days of receipt, and the final and official results will be published no later than 14 days after the Meeting.
5. All complaints, comments, and requests regarding participation in the Meeting may be submitted within 7 days of the end of the Meeting to the Organizer's email address warsawwalk@rkathletics.com or in writing to the Organizer's correspondence address also indicated in § 1, section 4, with the note "Complaint." The Organizer will review complaints within 14 days of their receipt by the Organizer.
6. In matters not regulated by the Regulations, the provisions of the Civil Code and relevant acts of Polish law, as well as European Union law, in particular the GDPR



(Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC), shall apply.

7. The date, place and/or route of the Meeting may be changed, and the Meeting may be cancelled in the event of circumstances that were unforeseeable on the date of publication of these Regulations or due to force majeure (e.g. unfavorable weather conditions, decisions of security or rescue services).
8. The final minutes of the Meeting will be published after April 20, 2026, i.e. after the end of the registration period and the end of the registration period.
9. The Organizer will publish all announcements related to the Meeting on the website www.walkingkorzeniowski.com in the "News" tab and on the Meeting's social media (including Facebook, Instagram, X).
10. Questions regarding the Regulations and the Meeting itself should be sent by e-mail to warsawwalks@rkathletics.com
11. The organizer reserves the right to make changes to these regulations, particularly in the event of a change in the situation, such as an epidemic (such as SARS-CoV-2), armed conflict, or changes in legal regulations. Participants who have registered will be kept informed of any changes to these regulations (via notice on the website, on Facebook, or by email).
12. The binding and final interpretation of these Regulations rests solely with the Organizer.
